



Premise Health's Near-Term Emission Reduction Targets Approved by Science Based Targets Initiative

Premise Health received approval from the **Science Based Targets** initiative (SBTi) of its near-term **science-based** emission reduction targets. By setting science-based targets, Premise is reinforcing its commitment to responsible growth, long-term resilience, and environmental stewardship.

SBTi is a corporate climate action organization that enables companies and financial institutions worldwide to play their part in protecting the planet. It develops standards, tools, and **guidance** to align greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets with the recommended actions needed to keep global heating low and reach net-zero by 2050 at latest.

Premise, utilizing 2019 as a base year, is committed to achieving the following by 2035:

- Reducing absolute Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions 67.2%.
- Reducing Scope 3 GHG emissions from purchased goods and services by 68.7% per USD value added.

Scopes 1 and 2 signify direct emissions from company-controlled sources and the indirect emissions from purchased energy. Scope 3 encompasses the carbon footprint embedded within the products, equipment, supplies, and services Premise Health acquires to support its healthcare operations across its wellness centers nationwide.

Premise will report annually on progress toward its approved science-based targets, while continuing to strengthen data quality, governance processes, and supplier collaboration for credible and transparent reporting.

The approval of its near-term emission reduction targets is part of Premise's broader sustainability strategy to foster impact-driven relationships with stakeholders across all populations, create data-centric program goals, and implement organizational initiatives that incorporate its environmental social governance principles. By aligning its emissions reduction strategy with up-to-date climate science, Premise Health affirms its role as a healthcare leader committed to its partners and members.

Premise's validated targets are based on the company's current scope and boundaries. In the event of a merger or acquisition, Premise will assess the transaction's impact on its targets and proceed with recalculation and revalidation if necessary.
